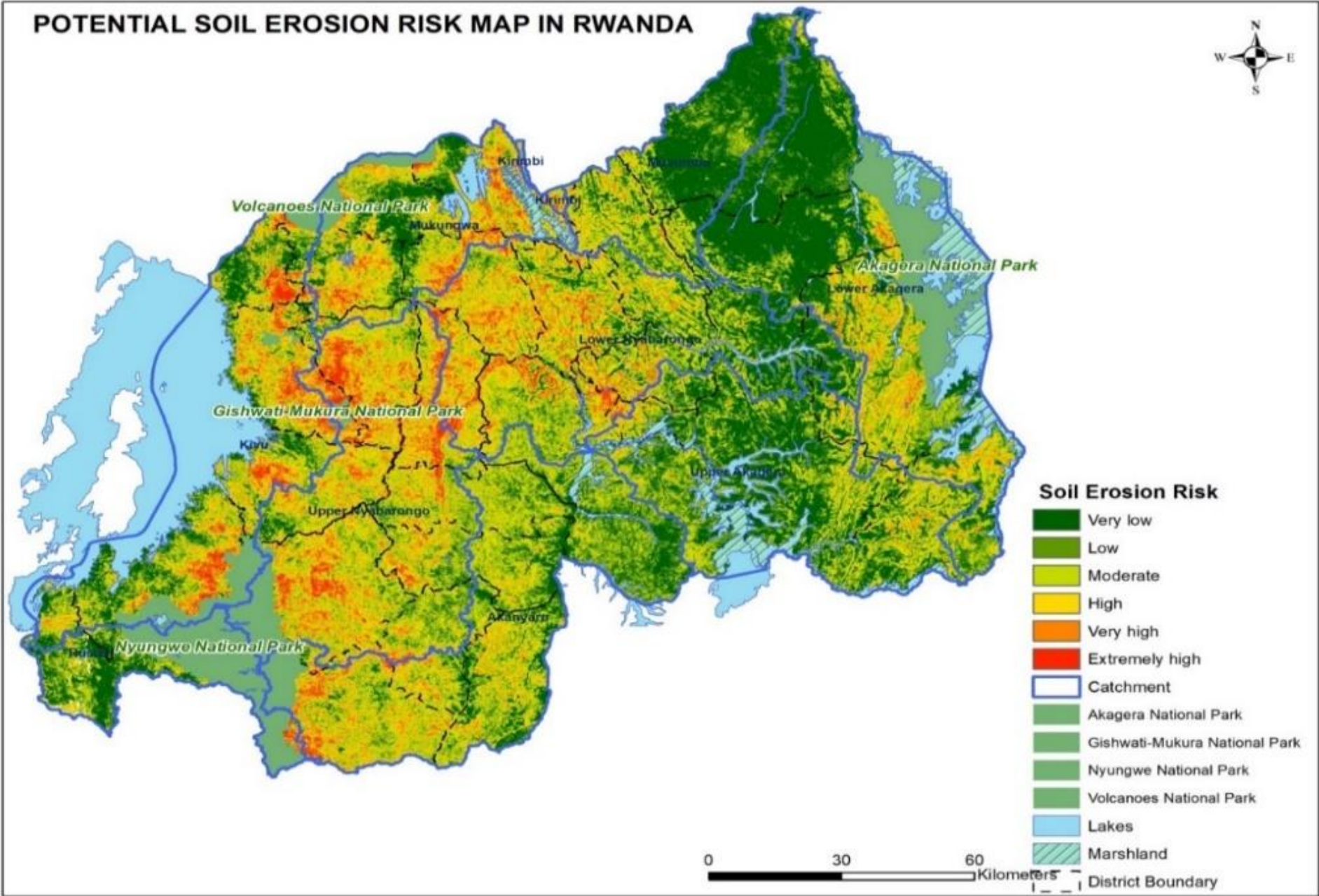

Project Components

- **Component 1: Protected area management, corridor sustainability, and community livelihoods**

- 1a. Volcanoes National Park Expansion and Restoration

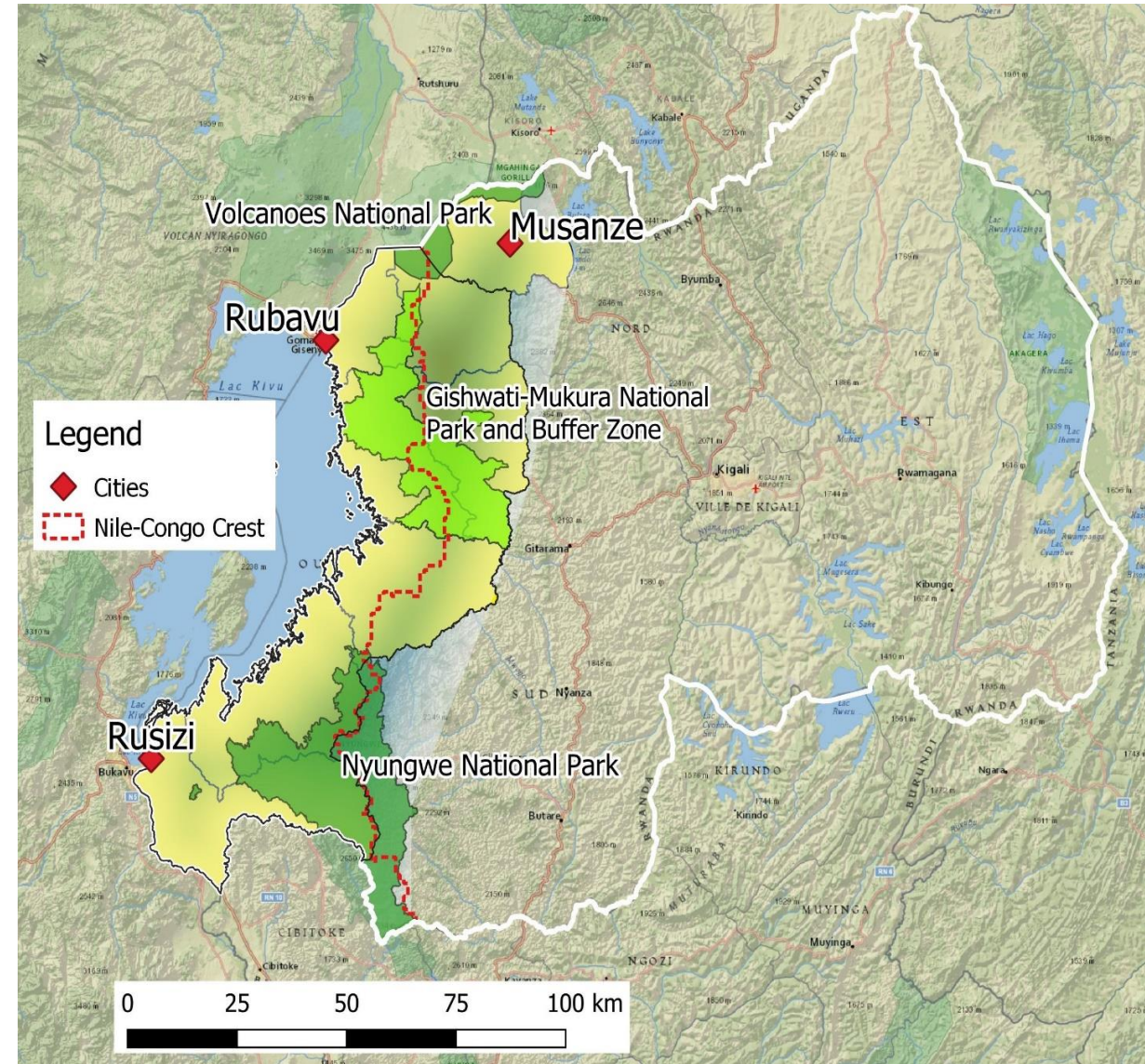
- Improve conservation based tourism to benefit the economy. and
- Improved quality of life for the Rwandans living around VNP.

- 1b. Corridor sustainability (Congo-Nile Ridge Area) towards:

- Support for incentive mechanisms for improved landscapes management, and
- multiple benefits for livelihoods to enhance climate and social resilience targeting the vulnerable poor communities in CNR.

- 1c. Community Adaptation Fund (depending on availability funding)

- Designed as a Climate-smart Lending Platform to incorporate climate risk in GoR grant/loan portfolios while incentivizing the adoption of climate-smart farming **practices** by smallholders.
- Promote investments in adaptation projects through scale up of existing CAF pilots in Rwanda

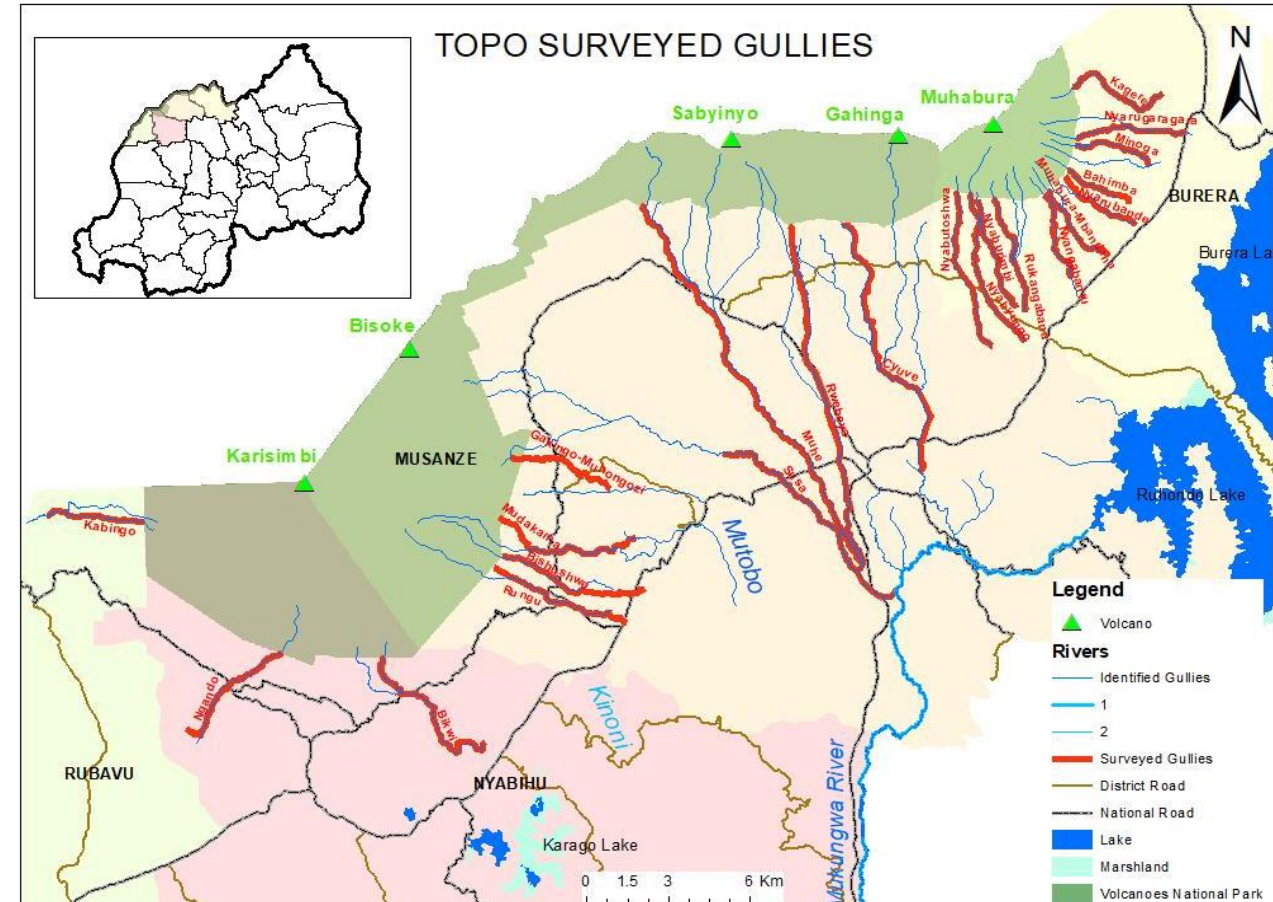


Project Components

Component 2. Flood Risk Management in the Volcanoes Region

Rehabilitation of critical watersheds
restoration of gully channels,
establishment of buffer zones on all
gullies.

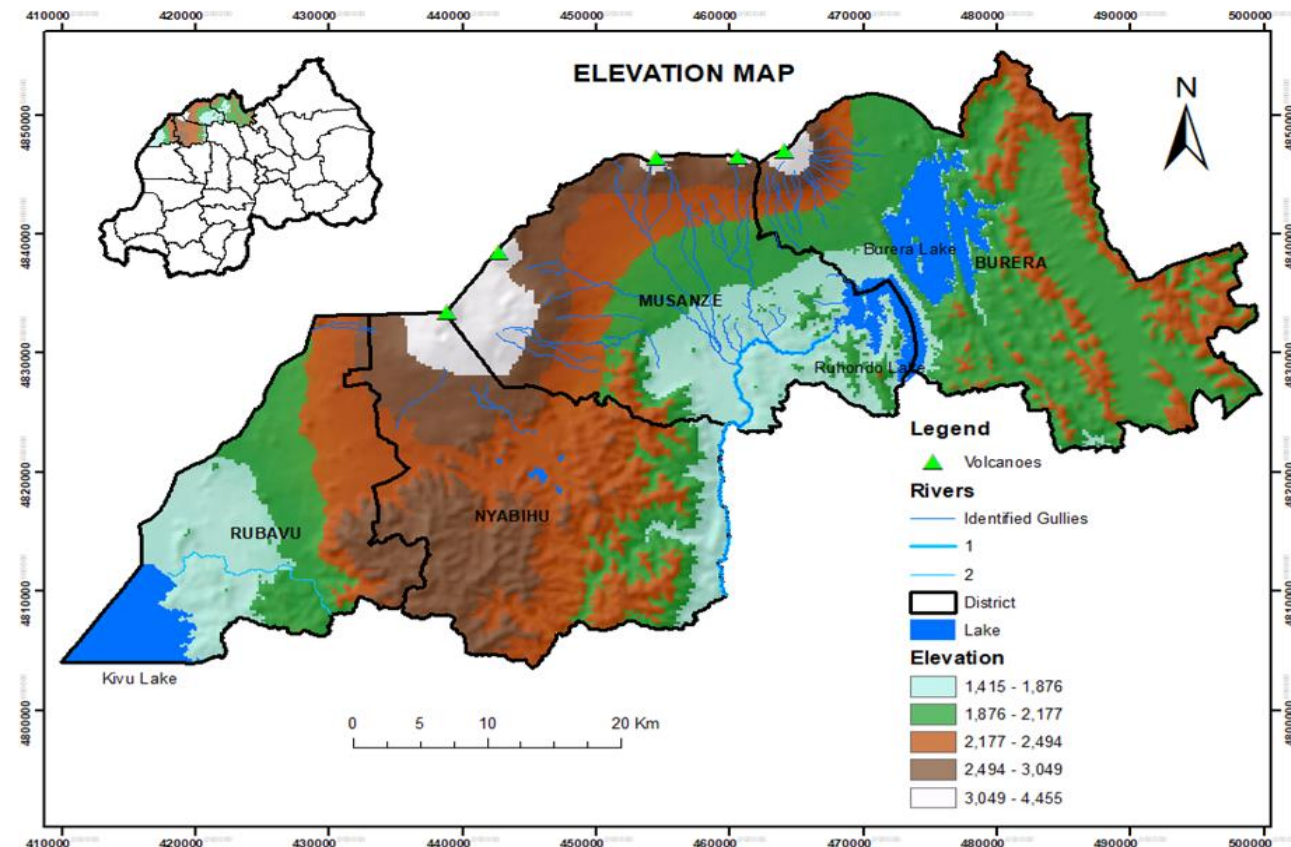
Nature-based solutions will improve the
environmental conditions, reduce erosion
and control runoff, and prevent further
enlargement of the gullies.



The Volcanoes Region is located in the north-west of Rwanda, and comprises the ***Districts of Rubavu, Nyabihu, Musanze, and Burera.***

Communities living in the region are highly vulnerable to adverse effects of climate change. The region is characterized by *frequent heavy rainfall and floods that damage infrastructure, properties, and threaten human lives as well as the tourism services in the region. Agricultural productivity, which underpins livelihoods and food security in the region, is also greatly affected. In addition, the topology of this area also triggers landslide that have a big impacts to community livelihoods*
